From the President's desk:

Ever since the Trust has come into being in 1990, it has provided 2472 limbs free of cost. It has facilitated 1442 cataract operations, organized 19 orphan marriages and repaired 217 limbs.

We have just completed a survey to organize another camp for the handicapped in which 60 lower and upper limbs will be provided. We have also recently organized cataract operations for 33 poor people from 23 remote villages.

As you must be aware, we are organizing another camp in Dec 2006 for the physically handicapped in Delhi with effect from 25th Dec 2006 till 2nd Jan 2007. We aim to give relief to 60 needy people who have lost their limbs due to militancy, cross border firing and the recent devastating earthquake. Our objective is to reinstate self-confidence in the handicapped and to give them a new lease of life.

I look forward to the support of all who also believe in our cause. The itinerary of the camp is listed.
