Founder's Note

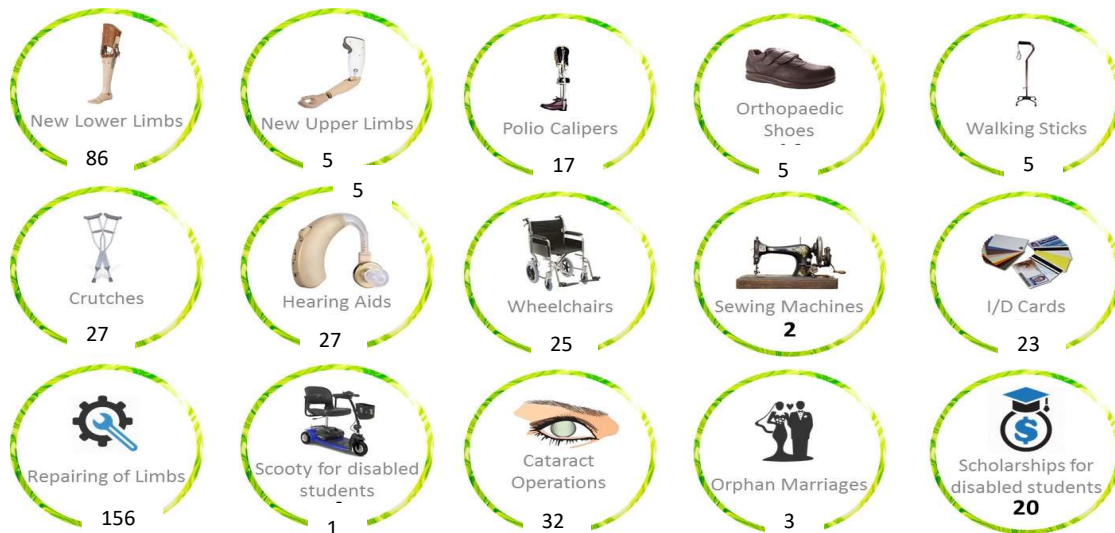

During Feb-2019, Pritam Spiritual Foundation commemorated the achievements of Brig.Pritam Singh-Saviour of Poonch (during 1947-48) and to mark the occasion, released a poster.

During Feb-2019, Pritam Spiritual Foundation organised an eye camp in Jammu for thirty two people, who were in dire need of cataract operations. Trust organised to and fro transportation, accommodation, meals and paid for cataract operations for these poor people.



During Nov – 2018, Pritam Spiritual Foundation organised a camp in Poonch and provided tailor made artificial limbs to 86 poor victims of remote border areas.

Beneficiaries included people of different caste, creed and religions as well as several women and children.

During April – 2018, Pritam Spiritual Foundation organised an eye camp in Chandigarh and organised cataract operations for 40 poor people through local support of Trust members.
